## Decluttering "On Purpose" Work Sheet

$\square$ Gifts
$\square$ Extra or old, off-topic books
$\square$ Unused or partial board games (missing pieces)
$\square$ Stuffed animals, pillows

## 10 Minute Decluttering Secret

Get three large plastic tubs and label them:
$\square$ "Put Away"
$\square$ "Give Away or Sell"
$\square$ "Throw Away"
Take 3 minutes to fill each one in sequence.
$\square$ Ask the custodian to empty the "Throw Away" tub.

- Take the "Give Away" tub to a local charity; Post Sellable items on Craigslist.
I Work through the "Put Away" tub during class breaks.
